

Air Pollution

is a very real problem for bees and other pollinators that rely on scent trails to find flowers.

Light Pollution

can harm moth pollinators by increasing their susceptibility to predation by bats or birds when they are attracted to artificial lights at night.

Climate Change

Studies predict that climate change will alter the close relationship between insect pollinators and the plants that depend on them. Flowering plants migrating north for cooler, higher elevation habitat in response to warming temperatures or other changes may not move in sync with their pollinators.
