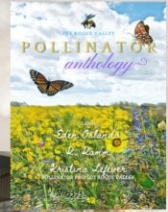


We've been busy in 2022, participating in at least 40 separate activities and events!

As of December 3, we have hosted or participated in:

- 13 outreach activities including *Looking and Learning: a Pollinator Adventure on Mount Ashland*, *Together We Rise* to commemorate the 2020 Fires, and 4 for the *Pollinator Anthology* gallery show and book.
- 9 *Pollinator Pals* youth instructions, including with the Boys & Girls Club in Jacksonville, at Ruch Elementary, and Armadillo Tech Institute
- 9 tabling events, including Earth Day - Ashland Food Co-op, Seed Day - Josephine County Food Bank, and Monarch Release - Phoenix
- 3 in person classes, including *Pollinator Gardens for Monarchs* with Tom Landis and *Plant Parenthood* with Arti Kirch and Patrice Hanlon
- 2 online presentations, including *Planting and Growing a Garden for Beauty and Diversity* with Robin McKenzie
- 2 multi-vendor Native Pollinator Plant Sales, plus 1 pop up
- and more!



We connected with over **2,280** youth and adults during these events

We raised and released **50** wild American Lady butterflies from eggs laid in our nursery



We welcomed our first AmeriCorps member, **Ethan Robison**, as our Pollinator Educator and Outreach Specialist, to develop our *Pollinator Pals* program for youth education. In his first 3 of 11 months, Ethan has engaged with 96 students at 3 schools, teaching about pollination, pollinators, plants, and more!

And that's not all! We also:

- Propagated over 1,000 plants from seed collected from our gardens
- Planted 162 plants in 4 *From Fire to Flowers* Pollinator Gardens
- Shared 45+ plants with community members
- Documented 6 Pollinator Counts in our demonstration garden
- Helped create and publish the 312-page *Pollinator Anthology*
