WHAT IS A POLLINATOR?

Pollinators play a vital role for both the environment and for human food systems by moving tiny grains of pollen between flowers, enabling them to reproduce. About 85% of all flowering plants need a pollinator to make fruit and seeds.

Pollinators like bees, flies, butterflies, moths, wasps, hummingbirds, and beetles (and more) live fascinating and complex lives. We teach how humans have harmed pollinators, and how we can work together to help them now.



WHAT IS A POLLINATOR PAL?

Pollinators, flowers, and food are often a part of a child's first relationship with the natural world. Anyone can be a Pollinator Pal by learning about and caring for these creatures and ecosystems.
