<p>This is a list of almost all of the butterfly species which have been recorded in Jackson County, along with their caterpillar host plants. Plenty of others might well be here, according to their range maps or a very small number of sightings. I've probably overlooked a few, so updates are welcome. Certainly more species will be seen and should be added to the data. iNaturalist.org is a good place to start.</p>	
<p>Many butterfly host plant associations are not known in any detail for Jackson County. This is an issue especially needing our contributions. Any sightings of caterpillars, eggs, or ovipositing gestures are helpful. Best of all is to rear the butterfly in a cage, feeding it a known plant species.</p>	
<p>About Names: Taxonomists have been examining specimens, DNA, and historical records. Many classifications and names have been changed since most reference books were printed. Scientific name updates migrate slowly through the community and publications, and the best experts often disagree. Common names change less often, but are not standardized so variations and disagreements occur. I've given all the names I know of, to help you locate species in older references. Botanists have been changing taxonomy even more, with many plants now in different families than before, and I don't know enough to help much with those.</p>
